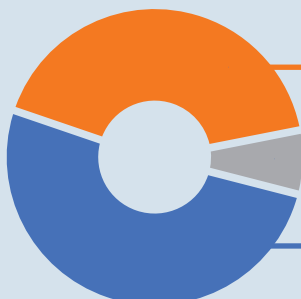

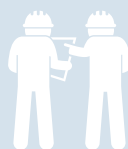
Water sources: past 7 days
