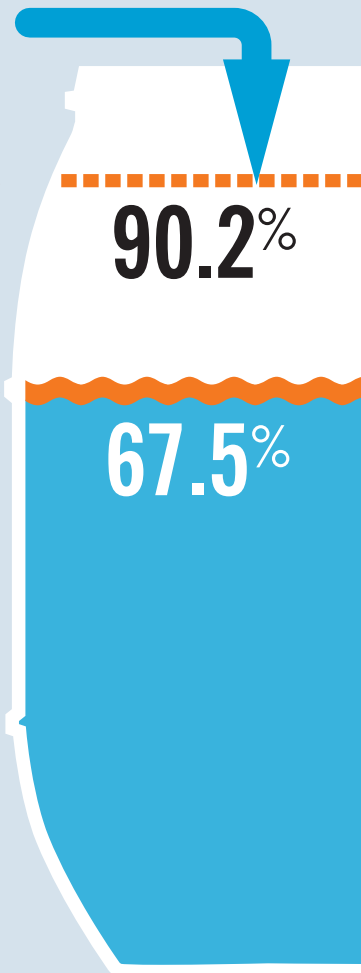

Actual consumption (rolling 7-day average)

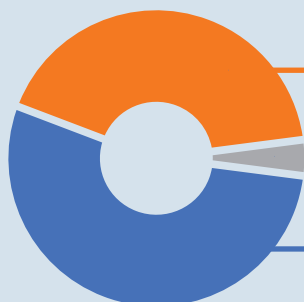

We are bringing a former water storage dam and bore back into service, and expanding the Waikato and Onehunga treatment plants.

Hays Creek, Papakura Deliver 6MLD\* by December 2020

Onehunga expansion, Onehunga Deliver 4MLD\* by Dec 2020
