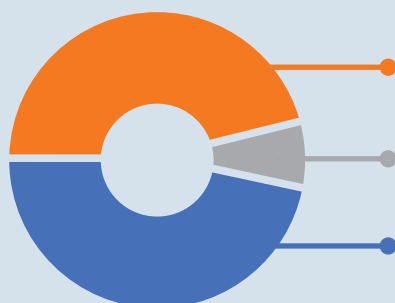

We are bringing a former water storage dam and bore back into service, and expanding the Waikato and Onehunga treatment plants.

Onehunga expansion, Onehunga **Deliver 4MLD\* by June 2021** ✓

Hays Creek, Papakura **Delivered 6MLD\* by February 2021** ✓

Hickey Springs Bores, Pukekohe **Delivered 5MLD\* in Oct 2020** ✓

Waikato expansion, Tuakau **Delivered 25MLD\* in August 2020** ✓
