

Huia No.1 Watermain replacement project

Improving the water network in Puketāpapa/Mount Roskill area

Pukewīwī/Puketāpapa/Mount Roskill Reserve watermain replacement

We are currently working to replace the watermain that runs from our Huia Water Treatment Plant to Epsom.

Project benefits:

- Replace aging infrastructure
- Cater for population growth and enable current and future development in the Puketāpapa/Mount Roskill area

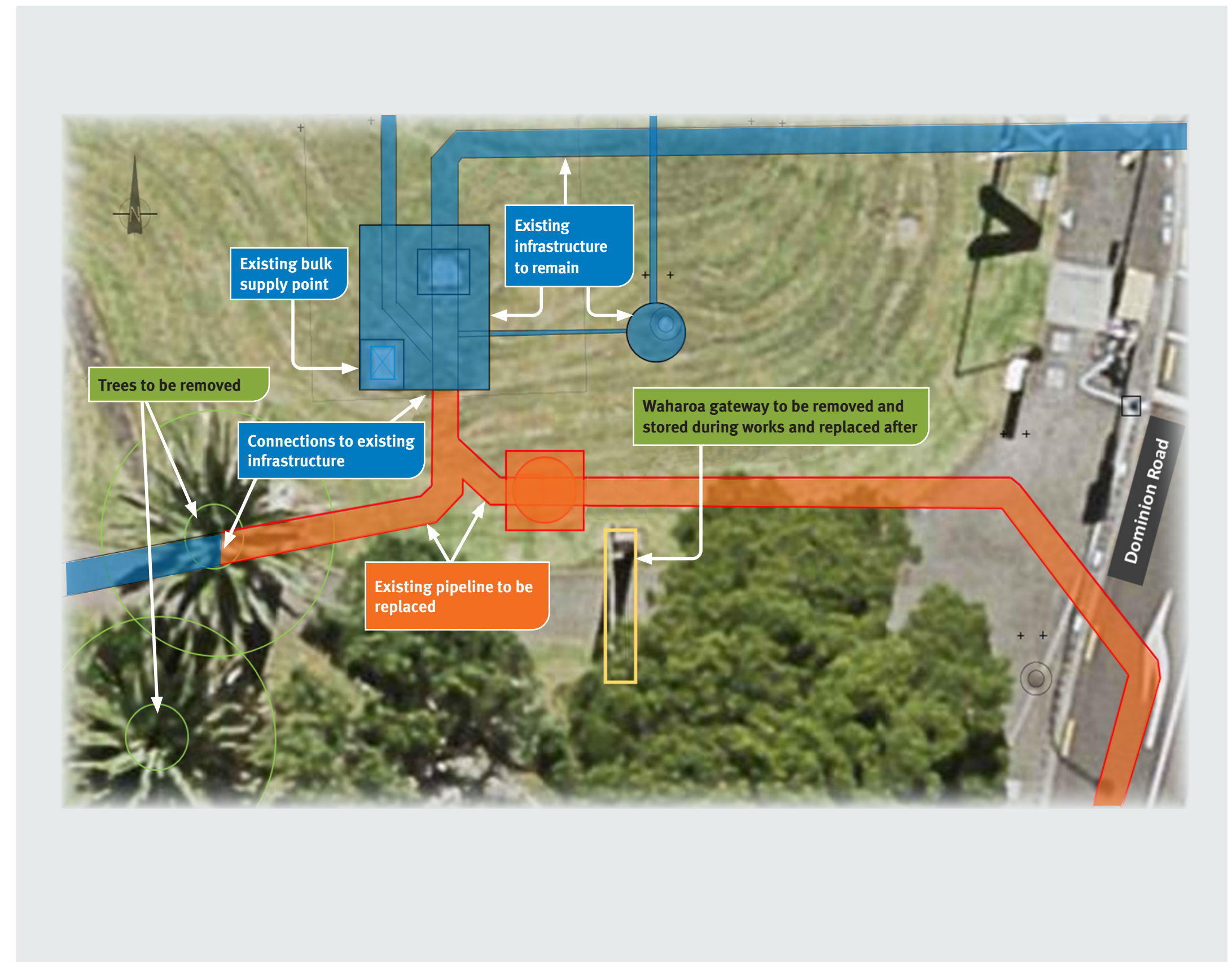
What is required?

We have now constructed the majority of the Huia No.1 pipeline in the Puketāpapa/Mount Roskill area and are nearing the completion of this section. We now need to install the final part of the replacement pipeline into the reserve. This includes connections to the existing infrastructure such as the supply point which serves water to the Puketāpapa/Mount Roskill area (please see the adjacent map). We will then test the new pipeline and bring the Puketāpapa/Mount Roskill section of the new pipeline into service, providing immediate capacity for the growing population.

Removal of two phoenix palms for construction works:

We will be removing two phoenix palms in close proximity to the replacement pipeline, in order to undertake construction. We will also be carefully removing the Waharoa gateway for the works and will restore this back to its position on completion of the works.

We have all the necessary permissions and will aim to commence construction at the end of June. It will take approximately four months to complete these essential works. The site will be fenced for public safety during construction.
