

Kahika wastewater upgrade project

Improving the wastewater network in Bay View, Beach Haven and surrounding suburbs

Welcome to our fourth newsletter, dedicated to keeping you informed about the Kahika wastewater upgrade project.

What has happened so far?

Despite the adverse conditions we have hit major milestones this past month. We have completed 55% of the scheduled pipe installation across the whole project, passing the half way point! We have also completed 35% of the road reinstatement.

In addition to this have relocated an Oak tree in Francis Kendall Reserve, cleaned up the road walkway and reinstated the traffic island on Kaipatiki road.

We also completed the pipe pull from the Kahika Wastewater Pump Station to Francis Kendall Reserve, completing 380 metres of pipe without the need for extensive excavation. Another major project milestone!

What can you expect in the coming weeks?

In the coming weeks both of our teams are proceeding onwards and filling in behind them. With this new asphalt we will be moving our traffic controls further forward. Around team one there will be road switches in the future as we round the corner of Kaipatiki road just before the Stanley Road roundabout.

Our second team is also drawing closer to Easton Park

Parade. When we proceed past that roundabout we will extend our traffic controls up the road.

How will our work affect you?

- Work hours – will be from 7:30am to 6pm on Monday to Friday with potential work on weekends.
- Noise – while the work may generate some noise and vibration, please be assured levels will be kept to a minimum and in accordance with Auckland Council and consent requirements.
- Traffic – temporary traffic management is in place on Kaipatiki Road and surrounding streets. As our works move forward this footprint will migrate up the road. Please refer to the map over the page for the current traffic plan in place.
- Section One – stop-go boards and temporary traffic lights in operation along Kaipatiki Road.
- Section Two – one lane closure on Kaipatiki Road with access from Stanley Road and with detour and no entry from Easton Park Parade.
- Speed limit will be reduced to 30km.
- Reduced on-street parking.
- Pedestrian, bike, car, and bus detours. Check the AT website/app for updates on bus route changes during Section 2.
- The traffic management plan will be in operation until May 2024.
