Clarks Beach has high ecological values and is located within a coastal protection area. There are features of cultural value in several receiving environments, including midden sites.


Significant growth and development are occurring in this catchment; however, our network can support it. We will continue to monitor growth to ensure it does not exceed network capacity.

**There will be no major proposed work over the next six years.**

At present three wastewater treatment plants serve communities at Waiuku, Clarks Beach and Kingseat. Southwest servicing scheme will construct pipework and replace with one plant. Check out the project details here:
