(combined with Waiwera)

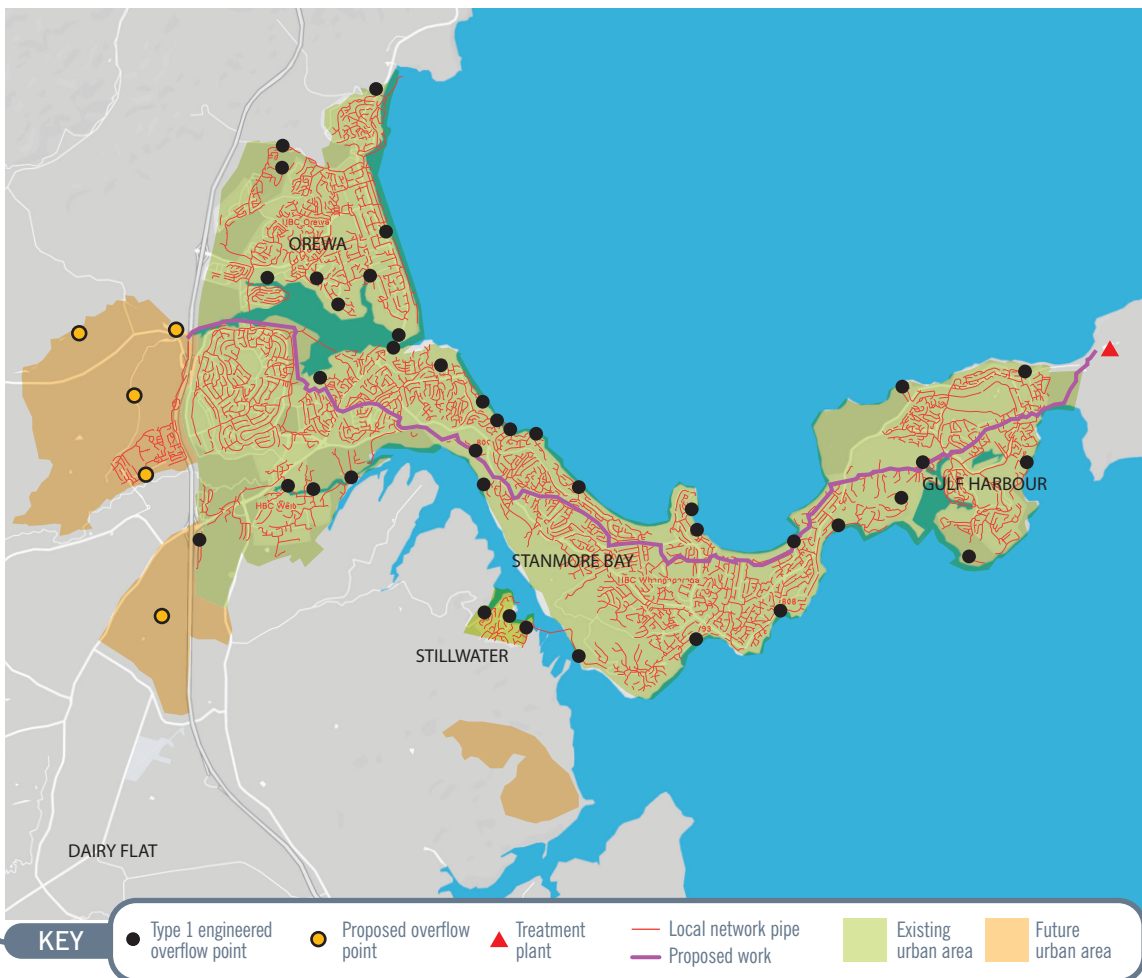
There are a number of cultural and environmental protection areas in this catchment. Several cultural sites around the region are near the overflow sites.

Major development is expected to occur at the fringes of the existing network.

Work proposed over the next six years

- Construction of a new network to cater for the projected population
- Replace critical ageing assets
- Orewa West pump station and associated network upgrade
- Bay St pump station upgrade
- Weiti pump station upgrade
- Terminal pump station upgrade of associated pipework and extension
- Hatsfield and Florence pump station upgrade

We will continue to maintain the network through renewal programmes, repairing ageing infrastructure and carrying out investigation works such as Inflow and Infiltration.
