## Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987

## Section 7 (2)

Subject to sections 6, 8, and 17, this section applies if, and only if, the withholding of the information is necessary to— (a) protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons; or (b) protect information where the making available of the information— (i) would disclose a trade secret; or

(i) would disclose a trade server; or
 (ii) would disclose a trade server; or
 (iii) would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information; or
 (ba) in the case only of an application for a resource consent, or water conservation order, or a requirement for a designation or heritage order, under the <u>Resource Management Act 1991</u>, to avoid serious offence to tikanga Maori, or to avoid the disclosure of the location of washi tapu; or

(i) the free and frank expression of opinions by or between or to members or officers or employees of any local authority, or any persons to whom section 2(5) applies, in the course of their duty; or
(f) maintain the earl or pressional privilee; or

(ii) the protection of such memory, official software persons from improper pressure of nonsament, of
 (g) maintain legal professional privilege; or
 (h) enable any local authority holding the information to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, commercial activities; or
 (i) enable any local authority holding the information to carry on, without prejudice or disadvantage, negotiations (including commercial and industrial negotiations); or
 (j) prevent the disclosure or use of official information for improper gain or improper advantage.
