

# CENTRAL INTERCEPTOR BULLETIN

## Walmsley Park site 727-761 Sandringham Rd Ext. Mt Roskill

### About Walmsley Park construction site

The Walmsley Park site is on the main Central Interceptor tunnel alignment between Western Springs and the Māngere Wastewater Treatment Plant. It is the fifth site to begin construction and includes a main shaft and connections to nearby wastewater networks which will help divert wastewater overflows.

### Site location

The site is located at the far eastern end of Walmsley Park in Mt Roskill with site access off Sandringham Road Extension. The site is split into two areas with Oakley Creek running through the site. The main

construction site is directly opposite the Wesley Community centre and youth facility. A second smaller material storage area is on the northern side of the creek and opposite Gifford Avenue. Access for both areas is from Sandringham Road Extension.

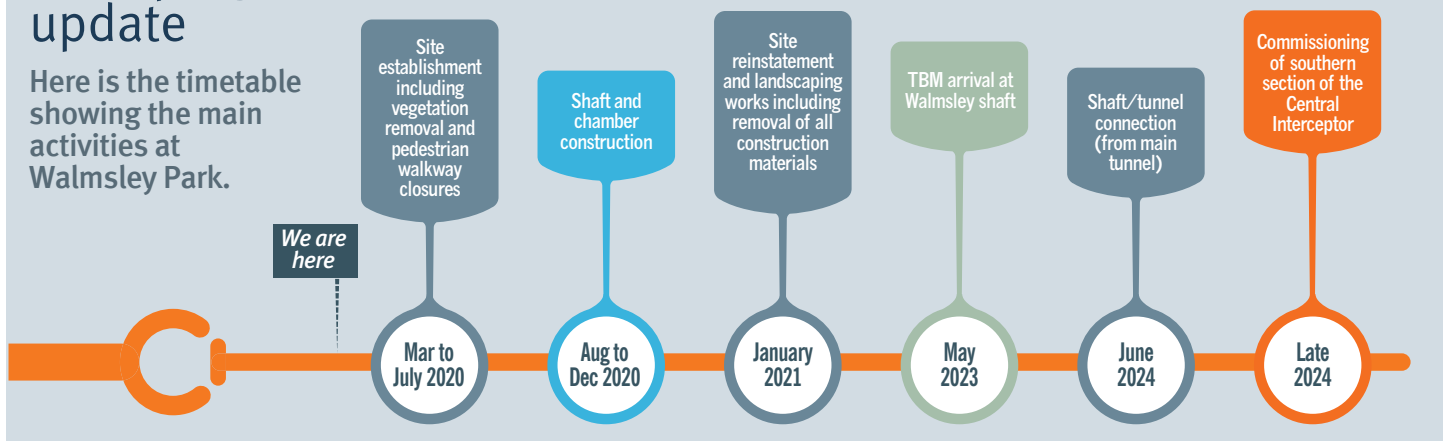
### Timing of work

The main construction works are due to start 31 March 2020 and will take approximately ten months to complete. When the works are complete, the site will be temporarily reinstated until the main tunnelling machine arrives at Western Springs. Our contractor will return to site in mid-2024 to connect the shaft to the new Central Interceptor tunnel.



## Work programme update

Here is the timetable showing the main activities at Walmsley Park.



### Working with you

We understand that construction sites for major projects such as the Central Interceptor can be disruptive and noisy at times. We aim to be a good neighbour while we are working in your area and will work to minimise disruption, where we can.

We will keep you informed with what's happening with regular communications. We will be out in your community during the works to meet with you and answer any questions you may have.

Our contractor will hold a 'Meet the Contractor' community event before work starts (details below).

### How will construction affect you?

- General work hours will be between 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 6pm on Saturday.
- For the safety of the public and workers, traffic management will be in place.
- The pedestrian crossing will be temporarily relocated away from the construction site.
- Truck movements are restricted during peak traffic and school pick up/drop off times.
- During peak traffic flows all traffic management will be clear of the roadway.
- The shared path on the southern side of Walmsley Park will be closed for the duration of works.
- The bus stop outside the community centre will be temporarily relocated approximately 60 metres towards O'Donnell Avenue.
- Noise levels and vibration will be managed in accordance with Council requirements. Noise barriers and fences will be used to minimise noise from construction.
