4. Bruce Riddolls – Geological Information – comments	
Bruce spoke to his report regarding his review of the geotechnical information that is	
currently available regarding the three parcels of land (subject to the proposed WTP	
replacement. He is of the opinion that Watercare is up to step 4 in the process set out	
in his report and subject to mapping the topographically features, such as the	
boulders at the bottom of the steep bank on Woodlands Park Road site, is sufficient	
to lodge applications with the Council.	
5. Update	P Jones
The Titirangi Protection Group and others have taken an appeal to the High Court on	
the matter of the decision of the Environment Court with regards to the status, etc of	
the designation over the Watercare land at Waima. The Court has set a hearing date	
of the 8 th May 2018.

Visual effect on Woodlands Park Road and Scenic Drive – once the layout of	

 the plant has been determined and the lidar survey of the canopy completed then the visual effect of the plant on public vantage points can be considered Stormwater treatment and disposal – this is yet to be considered Replacement of aqueduct from Mackie's Rest to WTP – this is still under investigation. Start of NH2 – there is no set date for the start of the project but it is assumed that the pipe (tunnel) from Woodlands Park Road will be completed prior to the erection of any reservoir on the land.
